



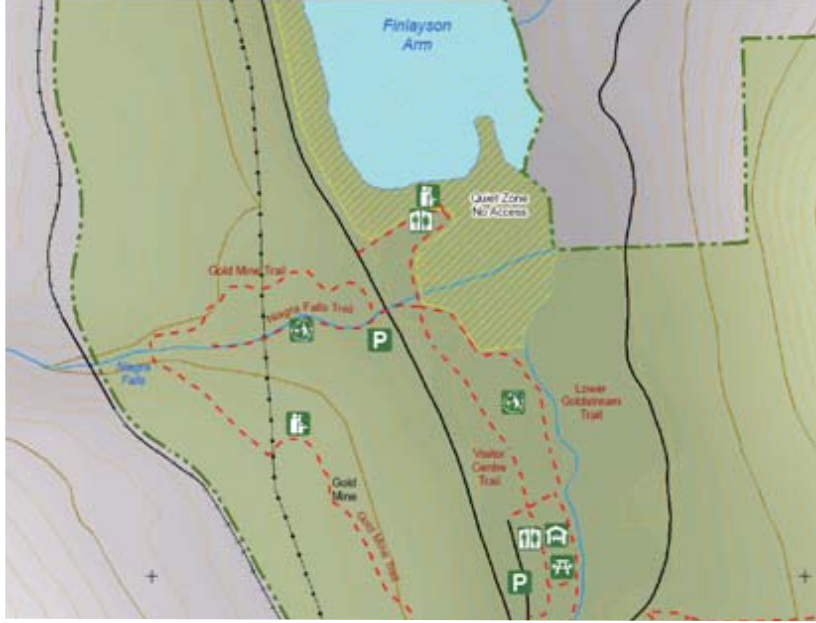
CloverPoint has supported the province of BC's Ministry of Environment BC Parks Branch since 1995 in areas ranging from core GIS data compilation, to sophisticated analysis, to the presentation of their business information in digital, hard-copy and web-deployed formats.

Issue:

There is a high demand for information on the management and use of BC Parks' approximate 1000 parks and protected areas. This information is disjointed across the vast regions of the province and often dated or even wrong, creating management concern and liability issues.

Solution:

Using a series of representative Provincial Parks, CloverPoint worked with BC Parks to develop a web-deployed model that would have a drill down capability to show overview mapping of an entire park down to specific campsites within the park as well as the other Facilities management data that exists for that park. This application would draw from the province's vast array of geo-spatial data stored in its Land and Resource Data Warehouse in real time thereby eliminating data redundancies, a strong provincial mandate where web-deployed applications are concerned.
